  - Shabbat Shalom (Avni) - change “on Friday night” to “when Shabbos comes”
  - Bim Bam
  - Hinei Mah Tov
  - If you’re Happy and you know it, with Hebrew body parts
  - Modeh Ani (Carol Boyd Leon)
- Daily Blessings with Visual Cues
  - Baruch Atah Adonai...thank you God for hands that hold, bodies that grow, etc.
  - Can add other things we are thankful for
- Barchu
- God Is Everywhere (Peter and Ellen Allard)
- Sh’ma
- Recognizing birthdays/accomplishments
- **Holiday Song**
- Torah Service
  - Come to the ark, open and hand out little stuffed Torahs
  - Hakafah: a “Torah Parade”
    - Sing Torah Torah, march with the Torah
  - Offer quick Parsha Summary for parents
  - Read Story (kids hold their Torahs)
- Putting the Torah(s) away
