	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 5 Min - Intro <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ After Torah service, explain that on Yom Kippur it is traditional for communities to read the book of Jonah. Today, we'll all work together to tell the story</li> <li>○ Have kids break into 10 groups, each group gets a scene from the story and has 10 minutes to plan their skit. Can't leave the room, no props, can get a pencil to write things down</li> </ul> </li> <li>• 10 Min - groups plan their skits</li> <li>• 5 Min - come back together, set expectation that we will be a respectful audience, remember that this story is part of our sacred text</li> <li>• 15 Min - presentation of skits</li> </ul>
